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# IN 10 YEARS, GOD TOOK THE SACRIFICE OF 30 PEOPLE AND TURNED IT INTO A DISCIPLE-MAKING MOVEMENT PLANTING CHURCHES ALL OVER THE WORLD.

In the fall of 2022, Pastor Andrew and Pastor Bobby stood on the stage and celebrated 10 years since the start of Mercy Hill, joined by the original group of 30 people who had leveraged everything to plant Mercy Hill. While recalling everything about the amazing journey of the past 10 years, they began to cast a vision for what the next 10 years could look like. The central idea revolved around the vision of a church leveraging everything for God in the same way God had worked in the original launch team. Right after this, the Deeper Initiative was officially launched. Deeper is a 2-year discipleship initiative where we challenge each person to ask the question, 'God, are you my deepest desire?' The hope is that this will ignite a movement of sacrifice and impact akin to the original launch team from 10 years prior. Imagine now in 2023, we don't just have 30 people going on this journey, but 3,000!

# AS A DEER PANTS FOR FLOWING STREAMS, SO PANTS MY SOUL FOR YOU, O GOD.

**PSALM 42:1** 

What God has done in and through our church is amazing. In just 10 years of ministry, we've grown from 30 to 3,000 in attendance, baptized 1,654 people, and sent 178 adults to the mission field long-term. God has blessed us immensely, church! The danger for us now is that we could become satisfied with the blessings of God rather than with God himself.

In the fall of 2022, our church started a discipleship journey called Deeper. We wanted to lay the foundation for the next season of ministry as a church by asking ourselves, 'Is God my deepest desire?'

In the Deeper Initiative, we have two primary goals: First, we want everyone who calls Mercy Hill home to wrestle deeply with the question, 'Is God my deepest desire?' We hope that, in answering 'yes,' we will give out of an overflow of love in our hearts. Our goal, then, is to have 100% participation in the Deeper Initiative from everyone at Mercy Hill. As of now, we have seen 786 households participate!

Our second goal is to raise 30 million dollars for mission advancement over two years. This money will be used to fund our ongoing ministries, build a new home and hub, and start new ministries. At the start of the Deeper Initiative, our church stepped up in a huge way! Praise God! We ended up with 32 million dollars in commitments and expected giving. As we approach the midpoint in this journey, I want to call upon our church to recommit. For some, that will mean jumping in for the first time. For others, it will mean finishing strong. Still, for some, it will mean going deeper in generosity to reflect what God is doing in our hearts. Are you ready to allow God to move in your heart, whatever that means? I hope so, church. As Psalm I tells us, when our roots go deep in God, the fruit goes wide in our life. When God is first in our hearts, he opens our hands for a life of generosity and mission. Let's get ready for what God is going to do in and through us next. The best is yet to come!

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

# Deeper Ministry - \$15 million

During this initiative, our focus is on making a more profound investment in our campuses, discipleship ministries, and ongoing church planting and mission efforts.



# Deeper Multiplication - \$10 million



This home and hub will be the launching pad for church plants, new campuses, seminary students, new residents, as well as host our broadcast campus.

**Through new mission opportunities...** We plan to deepen our mission efforts. This includes funding more short-term trips, scaling adoption and foster care ministry, planting more campuses through mergers, scaling our worship culture, offering residency scholarships, and making a deeper commitment to give towards international missions.

# **NEW HOME & HUB**LAUNCHING SPRING 2024

We are joining in God's work to continue making room for more and more people to come to know Jesus in the Triad and around the globe. The Ridge Campus will provide new and improved space for upcoming generations to be discipled without hindrance.

The Deeper Initiative will effectively set up the next 10 years at Mercy Hill. Achieving our goal of sending out 500 missionaries and witnessing 5,000 baptisms will depend on the success of this initiative.

# **INCREASE**

Some of us made our Deeper commitment a year ago, and it might have required significant sacrifice. It's possible that your faith or financial situation has grown since then. While keeping our commitment hasn't been easy, you may sense the Lord encouraging you to take an additional step of faith in generosity. We challenge you to respond to his call by increasing your commitment. Remember, generosity is not a one-time event; it's a continuous journey. Ask yourself if you're still giving in a way that challenges you and if God remains your deepest desire. Pray and consider if he's inviting you to take another step of faith with an increased commitment.

# GENEROSITY PATHINAY

At Mercy Hill we want to equip you to grow in generosity. We've developed the Generosity Pathway to help you see where you are right now and create clear next steps for your growth. As we move from beginning givers towards extravagant givers, we not only increase our giving but also our kingdom impact.

#### BEGINNING

Every journey begins with a first step. If you've never given before, take the first step on the Generosity Pathway by giving a gift today.

If you have given something in the past, but are not giving regularly, your next step is to become a consistent giver. Paul tells the Corinthian church to set aside some money every week for generosity. Setting up a recurring gift is a great way to become a consistent giver.

### **TITHING**


Simply put, tithing is giving the first 10% of everything God has given us back to God. Tithing is an important step that moves us from the act of giving towards a heart of true generosity.

#### **ABUNDANT**

Abundant giving goes above and beyond what might be normal or expected. When we take a step into abundant giving, it looks like consistently giving above the tithe in a way that showcases the transforming work Jesus has done in our lives.


#### EXTRAVAGANT

An extravagant giver lives a life that demonstrates that every single resource, financial or otherwise, is a gift from God and to be used for his glory. Taking a step into extravagant giving means there is nothing withheld, and every area of your life is freely and joyfully given for kingdom purposes.

[3] So Abraham rose early in the morning, saddled his donkey, and took two of his young men with him, and his son Isaac. And he cut the wood for the burnt offering and arose and went to the place of which God had told him. [4] On the third day Abraham lifted up his eyes and saw the place from afar. [5] Then Abraham said to his young men, "Stay here with the donkey; I and the boy will go over there and worship and come again to you." [6] And Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering and laid it on Isaac his son. And he took in his hand the fire and the knife. So they went both of them together. [7] And Isaac said to his father Abraham, "My father!" And he said, "Here I am, my son." He said, "Behold, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for a burnt offering?" [8] Abraham said, "God will provide for himself the lamb for a burnt offering, my son." So they went both of them together. [9] When they came to the place of which God had told him. Abraham built the altar there and laid the wood in order and bound Isaac his son and laid him on the altar, on top of the wood. [10] Then Abraham reached

out his hand and took the knife to slaughter his son. [11] But the angel of the LORD called to him from heaven and said, "Abraham, Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am." [12] He said, "Do not lay your hand on the boy or do anything to him, for now I know that you fear God, seeing you have not withheld your son, your only son, from me." [13] And Abraham lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, behind him was a ram, caught in a thicket by his horns. And Abraham went and took the ram and offered it up as a burnt offering instead of his son. [14] So Abraham called the name of that place, "The LORD will provide"; as it is said to this day, "On the mount of the LORD it shall be provided." [15] And the angel of the LORD called to Abraham a second time from heaven [16] and said, "By myself I have sworn, declares the LORD, because you have done this and have not withheld your son, your only son, [17] I will surely bless you, and I will surely multiply your offspring as the stars of heaven and as the sand that is on the seashore. And your offspring shall possess the gate of his enemies, [18] and in your offspring shall all the nations of the earth be blessed, because you have obeyed my voice." (ESV)
